4 **County of San Francisco for all official advertising for FY2014-2015 and ratifying the**
5 **Office of Contract Administration's extension of the previous advertising contract with**
6 **the San Francisco Chronicle for July 2014.**

8 WHEREAS, In each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the official
9 newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to Administrative Code,
10 Sections 2.80-1 and 2.81; and

11 WHEREAS, Based on the anticipated date of approval of this Resolution, and to
12 prevent the interruption of services to City Departments, the Office of Contract Administration
13 has executed a modification to the existing San Francisco Chronicle Agreement. The San
14 Francisco Chronicle Agreement dated July 1, 2013, has been extended by one month, or until
15 this Resolution has been adopted and signed, subject to ratification by the Board; now,
16 therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That *The Examiner*, a newspaper of general circulation published in the
18 City and County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news and
19 intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000 copies per
20 calendar week, printed in the City, is hereby designated as an official newspaper of the City
21 and County of San Francisco for the publication of all official advertising of the City and
22 County for FY2014-2015 starting on the effective date of this Resolution through June 30,
23 2015; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Office of Contract Administration is hereby
25 authorized to enter into a contract with *The Examiner* and said contract(s) must be in

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accordance with all the contracting requirements of the City and County of San Francisco;
and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board hereby approves and ratifies the modification
extending the term of the previous contract with San Francisco Chronicle as executed by the
Office of Contract Administration, copies of which are contained in Board of Supervisor's File
No. 140731.

On June 17, 2014, OCA submitted a resolution package designating *The Examiner* as the City's official newspaper for Fiscal Year 14-15.

There is no change to OCA's recommendation to designate *The Examiner* as the City's official newspaper for Fiscal Year 14-15. However, based on the anticipated date of approval of this Resolution and to prevent the interruption of services to City Departments, OCA executed a modification extending the previous contract term with the San Francisco Chronicle by one month (through July 31, 2014) or until this Resolution has been adopted and signed. The enclosed revised Resolution dated June 30, 2014 reflects these developments.

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

Subject: Resolution Designating Official Newspaper for FY 14-15

Enclosed is the resolution that would designate *The Examiner* as the City's official newspaper for all Advertising for Fiscal Year 14-15.

The attached table, "Summary of Official Advertising Bids for FY 14-15," shows that *The Examiner* submitted the only responsive bid for official advertising. The *San Francisco Chronicle's* bid was non-responsive because the *San Francisco Chronicle* is not printed in San Francisco. OCA regulations require that we officially recommend only responsive bidders for contract awards but the Board of Supervisors has historically used its discretion to award the Official Advertising contract to multiple bidders to best serve the City's official advertising needs. Last year, the Board of Supervisors recommended award of the Official Advertising contract to both newspapers in 6 month increments.

OCA also solicited bids for the services of a clearinghouse in addition to the usual bids for the official newspaper. The clearinghouse transmits the City's ads to the newspapers and handles invoicing and payment. OCA received one (1) responsive bid from The Daily Journal who has been providing clearinghouse services to the City for many years.

The total estimated contract value for FY 14-15 is \$48,000. Contract value has decreased over the last several fiscal years due to an increase in information being published on City department websites per legislative ordinance 318-10 (December 14, 2010) amending Chapter 2 of the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Article XII, Sections 2.96 through 2.100.

The third and fourth attachments are the Mayor's and Board's versions of San Francisco Ethics Commission Form 126, "Notification of Contract Approval."

San Francisco Chronicle is deemed non-responsive to minimum requirements according to Admin Code Section 2.81 because it is not printed locally.

Advertising Price is sum of Sample Ad A and Sample Ad B pricing for each newspaper.

In FY14-15 Bid Evaluation, The Examiner received 30.4 points out of 32 possible evaluation points. The SF Chronicle received 21.4 points.

The apparent high scorer is The Examiner.

In FY13-14, the contract was awarded to both the SF Chronicle and The Examiner in 6 month increments. The Examiner was awarded the business for the first half of the year. SF Chronicle was awarded the business for the back half of the year.
