I am an African-American, lesbian attorney who has lived in San Francisco (the Castro and the Mission) since 1990, and who has lived in Bernal Heights since 2004. I moved to San Francisco in 1990 after growing up in the Queensbridge Housing Projects and attending public schools. In my legal practice, I have, among others, represented the indigent, workers, people of color, LGBT people and some of the most vulnerable amongst us. I have fought for marriage equality as lead pro bono counsel for former Mayor Gavin Newsom, former Assessor Mabel Teng, and the City and County of San Francisco. I also sat on the board of the National Center for Lesbian Rights for 6 years. And, I have worked at the Legal Aid Society-Employment Law Center representing indigent communities.

# Business and/or professional experience:

Perkins Coie LLP - Litigation Partner. I was the first African-American female partner in the 98 year history of the firm. My practice includes developing our Taiwan legal practice.

Howard Rice et al - Chair of IP Group/Litigation Director. I was the firm's first African-American lesbian Litigation Director in 1998.

Legal Aid Society - Employment Law Center - Fellow. I represented farm workers, low income workers, black firefighters, and coauthored "Reproductive Hazards in the Workplace."

I attended Columbia University School of Law and Queens College in NY.

## **Board Qualifications:**

The Board of Appeals consists of five (5) members, two (2) nominated by the President of the Board of Supervisors, and three (3) members nominated by the Mayor. Each nomination of the Mayor and the President of the Board of Supervisors is subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors. If the Board fails to act on the nomination within 60 days from the date the nomination is transmitted to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, the nominee shall be deemed approved.

In order to stagger the terms, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall determine by lot which two (2) of the three (3) Mayoral appointees shall serve an initial two-year term, and which one of the two (2) appointees of the President of the Board of Supervisors shall serve an initial-two year term. The remaining appointees shall serve four-year terms. All subsequent terms shall be four years.

The appointees of both the Mayor and the President of the Board of Supervisors shall take office at 12:00 noon on the first day of July 2002.

The Board of Appeals, a quasi-judicial panel, decides appeals of permits, variances, zoning determinations and other department actions at public hearings.
