

CET A RESUME A good resume can be the key to getting the job you want. We will refer you to our partners who will work with you to create a resume that will make your skills shine.

HELP WITH A SUSPENDED LICENSE

If your driver's license is suspended due to failure to pay child support, we will work with you to get it back.

HOW DO I QUALIFY? YOU QUALIFY FOR C-NET IF:

- You have a child support case with the San Francisco Department of Child Support Services with at least one minor child.
- You are unemployed or you do not work enough hours to make your child support payments.
- You have the desire to work and train hard to improve your financial circumstances.
