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3	Resolution adopting the 2014 City and County of San Francisco Hazard Mitigation Plan.
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5	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco ("the City") recognizes the threat
6	that natural and human-caused hazards pose to people and property within its community;
7	and
8	WHEREAS, Undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to
9	people and property from future hazard occurrences; and
10	WHEREAS, The federal government defines "hazard mitigation" as "any action taken to
11	reduce or eliminate the long-term risk to human life and property from hazards"; and
12	WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") requires local
13	governments to adopt a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition of future funding for
14	mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs, and
15	requires local governments to update their Hazard Mitigation Plans every five years; and,
16	WHEREAS, In 2005, the City adopted a Hazard Mitigation Plan prepared by the
17	Association of Bay Area Governments; and
18	WHEREAS, In 2008, the City adopted the 2008 City and County of San Francisco
19	Hazard Mitigation Plan ("2008 Hazard Mitigation Plan"), which contained comprehensive, city-
20	wide hazard identification, including the probability of particular risks, as well as a risk
21	assessment and an impact analysis; and
22	WHEREAS, The Department of Emergency Management, in cooperation with 20 City
23	departments, has prepared a 2014 City and County of San Francisco Hazard Mitigation Plan
24	("2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan"), which contains comprehensive city-wide hazard
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1	identification, including the probability of particular risks, as well as a risk assessment and an
2	impact analysis; and
3	WHEREAS, The 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan includes the following components:
4	Planning Area Description, Planning Process, Hazard Analysis, Vulnerability Analysis,
5	Capability Assessment, Mitigation Strategy, Plan Maintenance, and References; and
6	WHEREAS, The City fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning
7	process to prepare the 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
8	WHEREAS, The California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA have pre-
9	approved the 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan, contingent upon official adoption of the Plan by the
10	City; and
11	WHEREAS, Adoption of the 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan by the City demonstrates our
12	commitment to hazard mitigation and to achieving the goals outlined in the Plan; now,
13	therefore, be it
14	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco adopts the 2014 City and
15	County of San Francisco Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan of the City; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Executive Director of the Department of Emergency
17	Management shall submit this Resolution to the FEMA Region IX officials to obtain final
18	approval of the Plan.
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
