Multiple international studies have shown that daily use of PrEP can nearly eliminate the risk of contracting HIV. Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) is the use of the antiretroviral medication, Truvada, by those who are HIV negative. Because of its successes, PrEP is an important tool to prevent infection that is meant to supplement existing safer sex options. San Francisco is at the forefront of efforts to control the spread of HIV. San Francisco's bold response to HIV/AIDS in earlier decades changed the course of the epidemic. As access to new treatments becomes available, San Francisco needs to continue its legacy of leadership.

I am requesting a hearing regarding San Francisco's approach to HIV/AIDS prevention through the implementation of PrEP. I am calling on the San Francisco Department of Public Health to publicly present to the Board of Supervisors their past efforts efforts in testing this preventative drug, their current efforts to educate providers and
