[Closed Session - Anticipated Litigation - Establishing a Homeownership Stabilization Authority]

Motion that the Board of Supervisors convene in closed session on October 28, 2014, for the purpose of conferring with, or receiving advice from the City Attorney regarding anticipated litigation relating to the potential negotiation or adoption of a Joint Powers Agreement with the City of Richmond to establish a Homeownership Stabilization Authority to assist homeowners with troubled mortgages, in which the City is a potential defendant; pursuant to California Government Code, Section 54956.9(a), and San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 621.10(d)(2), which permit this closed session because discussion in open session concerning this matter would likely and unavoidably prejudice the position of the City in anticipated litigation.

WHEREAS, California Government Code, Section 54956.9(a), and San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 621.10(d)(2), allow the Board of Supervisors to convene in closed session to confer with or receive advice from legal counsel regarding anticipated litigation; and

WHEREAS, In the opinion of the Board of Supervisors on the advice of the City
Attorney, based on existing facts and circumstances, there is a significant exposure to
litigation against the City and County of San Francisco relating to the potential negotiation and adoption of a Joint Powers Agreement with the City of Richmond to establish a

Homeownership Stabilization Authority to assist homeowners with troubled mortgages; and

WHEREAS, On October 28, 2014, the Board of Supervisors will consider a Resolution (Board File No. 140709) directing the Director of the Mayor's Office of Housing, in consultation

with the City Attorney's Office, to negotiate a joint exercise of powers agreement with the City
