The San Francisco Alternative Fuels Planning Project is a collaboration of the City and County of San Francisco, the San Francisco Clean Cities Coalition, and EV Communities Alliance. The Project goal is to accelerate the adoption of Alternative Fuel Vehicles (AFV) and promote the use of Alternative Fuel Infrastructure (AFI) in the San Francisco area.
