14	Section 1. The Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended by revising	
15	Article 7, Section 506, to read as follows:

19	(a)	Upon a permanent resident-:
20	(b)	Upon a corporation or association having a formally recognized exemption from

23	(c)	Where the rent is less than at the rate of $\$3040$ a day or \$100 per week. For
24	multiple-occupancy guest rooms where the hotel determines who will share the rooms, the	
25	exemption shall be based on the rent charged per person.	

1	(d) Between three years and five years after the effective date of the ordinance setting the		
2	daily exemption amount in subsection (c) as \$40 a day, the Controller's Office shall review the		
3	exemption amounts in subsection (c), and make a written report and recommendation to the Mayor as		
4	to whether the amounts should be adjusted to take into account, among other things, changes in the		
5	economy; the cost of living; impact on the City's revenue; and affordability and overall impact on the		
6	market for hotel guest rooms subject to the transient occupancy tax.		
7			
8	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after		
9	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the		
10	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board		
11	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.		
12			
13	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors		
14	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,		
15	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal		
16	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment		
17	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under		
18	the official title of the ordinance.
