[Donation of Obsolete Self Contained Breathing Apparatus to City College of San Francisco Fire Sciences Program]

Resolution authorizing the Fire Department to donate thirty obsolete Self Contained Breathing Apparatus to the City College of San Francisco Fire Sciences Program.

WHEREAS, City College of San Francisco is a leading educational institution for Fire Sciences and teaches those who wish to become First Responders and Firefighters; and

WHEREAS, A large part of firefighting training focuses on manipulative skills and simulated drills with the aid of genuine equipment; and

WHEREAS, Firefighting and Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBAs) equipment is expensive and difficult to obtain; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department has recently purchased modern and state-of-the-art breathing apparatus, thus rendering thirty SCBAs obsolete and surplus property with very little value; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department wishes to donate thirty retired SCBAs for educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, These SCBAs would serve as a valuable teaching tool for donning and doffing and fire drills, and City College would benefit from these devices as training aids; and

WHEREAS, On September 12, 2013, the Fire Commission adopted Resolution 2013-04, Recommending that the Board of Supervisors Approve the Donation of Thirty Obsolete Self Contained breathing Apparatus to City College of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The Fire Commission Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140698, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 21 of the Administrative Code allows the City to dispose of surplus commodities in a manner that will best serve the City's interests, including maximizing the City's economic return on surplus commodities, maximizing the re-use of surplus commodities by public entities, non-profit organizations and schools, and avoiding unnecessary additions to the waste stream by maximizing the re-use and recycling of surplus commodities; and,

WHEREAS, In donating surplus commodities, the Administrative Code specifies that the first priority shall be to donate the commodities to public entities, non-profit organizations, or private organizations serving the public and physically located in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, City College fulfills the criteria set in the Administrative Code for donating surplus City commodities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Fire Department is authorized to donate thirty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus to City College of San Francisco, for use in its Fire Sciences Program.

RECOMMENDING THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVE THE DONATION OF THIRTY OBSOLETE SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS TO THE FIRE SCIENCES PROGRAM AT CITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, City College of San Francisco is a leading educational institution for Fire Sciences, and teaches those who wish to be future Firefighters and First Responders; and,

WHEREAS, a large part of firefighting training is concerned with manipulative skills and the best way to learn those skills is to practice on actual equipment; and,

WHEREAS, firefighting and Self Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment is expensive and difficult to obtain and the San Francisco Fire Department wishes to donate thirty retired SCBAs for educational purposes; and,

WHEREAS, these thirty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus have been retired from service, even as spares; and,

WHEREAS, these Self Contained Breathing Apparatus would serve as teaching tools for donning and doffing and fire drills, and City College would benefit from these devices as training aids; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Fire Department may donate thirty obsolete Self Contained Breathing Apparatus to City College of San Francisco. In the event City College of San Francisco should close, or the program is no longer in existence, the Fire Department would like the SCBAs to be donated to another institution for educational purposes or to be disposed of in an appropriate manner.
