

1 [Contract Agreement - State Department of Health Care Services - Substance Use Disorder
2 Services - FYs 2014-2017 - \$33,250,026]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health,**
4 **Behavioral Health Services (DPH-BHS) to enter into a multi-year contract for Substance**
5 **Use Disorder Services with the State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) for**
6 **the term of July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017, in the amount of \$33,250,026 and**
7 **authorizing and designating the DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator to sign**
8 **said Agreement and to approve amendments for less than 10% of the contracted**
9 **amount.**

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11 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) provides
12 substance use disorder services for Medi-Cal beneficiaries; and

13 WHEREAS, Oversight of these substance use disorder services is provided by the
14 DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator within DPH's Behavioral Health Services branch
15 (DPH-BHS); and

16 WHEREAS, The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is responsible
17 for the administration of Medi-Cal services contracts; and

18 WHEREAS, On October 14, 2014, DHCS forwarded to the San Francisco Alcohol and
19 Drug Administrator a Multi-Year Contract for Substance Use Disorder Services for the term of
20 July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017, in the amount of \$33,250,026 (Agreement); and

21 WHEREAS, DHCS requires the Agreement be signed by the Board of Supervisors or
22 their designee and submitted by close of business on December 15, 2014; and

23 WHEREAS, DHCS requires a resolution, board minutes, order, motion, or ordinance
24 from the Board of Supervisors that specifically approves and authorizes execution of the
25 Agreement; and

1 WHEREAS, The Agreement includes a hold harmless clause, which provides that the
2 City will hold the State harmless from (1) any claims and losses resulting to contractors,
3 subcontractors, individuals, firms, and corporations furnishing or supplying work services,
4 materials, or supplies in connection to the performance of this contract, and (2) any claims
5 and losses resulting to any person, firm, or corporation who may be injured or damaged in
6 connection to the City's performance of this contract; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That DPH-BHS is hereby retroactively authorized to enter into a FYs
8 2014-2017 Substance Use Disorder Services Contract with DHCS for the term of July 1,
9 2014, through June 30, 2017, in the amount of \$ 33,250,026, and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Agreement shall include an indemnification of the
11 State of California as set forth above; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator is
13 hereby authorized and designated by the Board of Supervisors to sign said Agreement and to
14 approve Agreement amendments for less than ten percent (10%) of the contracted amount.
