("K & L Wine Merchants") has applied to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to transfer its existing Type 21/42/86/77 alcohol beverage licenses from its current location at 638 4th St. to a new location within the same census tract at 855 Harrison St. Because the census tract has an "undue concentration" of off-sale licenses under Section 23958.4 of the Business and Professions Code, we are requesting a determination by the Board of Supervisors that public convenience or necessity will be served by issuance of the licenses.

Our store has been in the neighborhood for 23 years, originally at 768 Harrison St. and 766 Harrison St., and for the past 11 ½ years at our current location on 4th St. near Brannan. K & L Wine Merchants is a family-owned company, in business since 1976. We specialize in the sale of premium wines and spirits. We do not sell tobacco, food products, or inexpensive small sizes of spirits. Many of our wine professionals reside in San Francisco, and several of our staff members have been with us for 10-15 years.
