Ordinance amending the Health Code to eliminate the requirement that gasoline stations provide separate toilet facilities for men and women.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Health Code is hereby amended by revising Section 725, to read as follows:

SEC. 725. GASOLINE STATIONS.

It shall be unlawful for al ny person or persons to operate operating a service station for the sale and dispensing of gasoline, other motor fuels, or lubricating oil directly into motor vehicles or watercraft an attendant service station, a marine service station, a partial self-service station or a self-service gasoline station, pursuant to Section 8.12, et seq., of the San Francisco Fire Code, without providing shall provide at all times a clean and sanitary toilet and washroom for the use of it's the station's patrons. There shall be one separate toilet facility for men and one separate toilet facility for women. At the request of the Fire Department, the Department of Public Health shall inspect a proposed attendant service, marine service, partial self-service, or self-service gasoline service station and certify to the Fire Department that said station is in compliance with the provisions of this section 725.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
