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3 **Resolution declaring the results of the November 4, 2014, Consolidated General**
4 **Election.**

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6 WHEREAS, A Consolidated General Election was conducted in the City and County of
7 San Francisco on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, which placed before the electorate candidates
8 for election to City and County and other local offices, City and County ballot measures,
9 candidates for election to state offices, state ballot measures, and candidates for judicial

12 Francisco, has certified the results of the Consolidated General Election, a copy of which is
