3 **Motion appointing Deleano Seymour (residency requirement waived), Kim Armbruster,**
4 **and Erick Brown, terms ending October 21, 2018, to the Local Homeless Coordinating**
5 **Board.**

7 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Local
9 Homeless Coordinating Board, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. 827-97 and
10 Resolution No. 926-99, for the terms specified:

11 Deleano Seymour (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding himself, term
12 expired, must be a representative of homeless, formerly homeless, a community and
13 advocacy organization, a service-provider agency, business and corporate sector, or the
14 foundation community, for a four-year term ending October 21, 2018.

15 Kim Armbruster, seat 3, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a representative of
16 homeless, formerly homeless, a community and advocacy organization, a service-provider
17 agency, business and corporate sector, or the foundation community, for a four-year term
18 ending October 21, 2018.

19 Erick Brown, seat 4, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a representative of
20 homeless, formerly homeless, a community and advocacy organization, a service-provider
21 agency, business and corporate sector, or the foundation community, for a four-year term
22 ending October 21, 2018.

23 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 24 1. The membership of the Local Homeless Coordinating Board has a goal to be
25 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

2. Applicant Deleano Seymour, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him to serve on the Local Homeless Coordinating Board.
3. The Local Homeless Coordinating Board has attempted to fill the position, for which Deleano Seymour was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Deleano Seymour is qualified to serve on the Local Homeless Coordinating Board.
4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Local Homeless Coordinating Board at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Deleano Seymour, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101, that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
