[Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code - Conflict of Interest Code Amendments]

Ordinance amending the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code to update the Conflict of Interest Code for the City, the Community College District, the Local Agency Formation Corporation, the San Francisco Unified School District, the County Transportation Authority, and the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency, by adding, deleting, and changing titles of designated officials and employees to reflect organizational and staffing changes, and by refining the disclosure requirements applicable to some designated officials and employees.

Deletions to Codes are in <u>strikethrough italics Times New Roman font</u>. Board amendment additions are in <u>double-underlined Arial font</u>. Board amendment deletions are in <u>strikethrough Arial font</u>. Asterisks (* * * *) indicate the omission of unchanged Code subsections or parts of tables.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby amended by revising Sections <u>3.1-102, 3.102.5, 3.1-120, 3.1-135, 3.1-140, 3.1-145, 3.1-150, 3.1-155, 3.1-175, 3.1-185, 3.1-190, 3.1-195, 3.1-205, 3.1-218, 3.1-225, 3.1-251, 3.1-252, 3.1-253, 3.1-267, 3.1-275, 3.1-285, 3.1-312, 3.1-315, 3.1-320, <u>3.1-335, 3.1-340, 3.1-345, 3.1-362, 3.1-365, 3.1-410, 3.1-420, 3.1-435, and 3.1-510, to read as follows:</u></u>

SEC. 3.1-102. FILING REQUIREMENTS.

(a) Officers and Employees. Each officer and employee of the City and County of San Francisco holding a position designated in this Chapter, other than those officials identified in Section 3.1-500, shall file statements disclosing the information required by the disclosure categories set forth in this Chapter, on such forms as may be specified by the Fair Political

Practices Commission in a format specified by the Ethics Commission (Form 700 unless otherwise provided by the Commission), and at such times required by Regulation 18730. A copy of the forms to be used shall be supplied by the Ethics Commission to each filing officer. <u>upon request</u>. Every officer and employee holding a position designated in this Chapter shall retain his or her filing obligations, notwithstanding any reclassification or title change that may occur in the future as to the same job duties.

(b) Candidates. Each candidate for City elective office, as that term is defined in Chapter 1 of Article I of this Code, shall file no later than the final filing date for a declaration of candidacy, a statement disclosing the information required by the disclosure category for the City elective office sought by the candidate. Candidates shall file such statements with the Department of Elections on the same forms as used by filers under subsection (a) of this Section. This statement shall not be required if the candidate has filed, within 60 days prior to the filing of his or her declaration of candidacy, a statement for the same jurisdiction pursuant to this Chapter or Sections 87202 or 87203 of the California Government Code.

SEC. 3.1-102.5. FAILURE TO FILE.

(a) Subject to the removal and Civil Service provisions of the Charter as well as any applicable Civil Service Rules, any officer or employee of the City and County of San Francisco who fails to file any statement required by Sections 3.1-101 and 3.1-102 of the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code within 30 days after receiving notice from the Ethics Commission of a failure to file may be subject to disciplinary action by his or her appointing authority, including removal from office or termination of employment.

(b) The Ethics Commission may issue a letter to an appointing authority recommending <u>suspension or</u> removal of any City officer or termination of any City employee who has failed to file a statement required by Sections 3.1-101 and 3.1-102 of the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code if the City officer or employee has not filed the required

statement within 30 days of receiving notice from the Ethics Commission of his or her failure to file.

(c) [Reserved.]

SEC. 3.1-120. AIRPORT.

(a) Disclosure Category 2. Persons in this category shall disclose all investments and business positions in business entities and income from any source which provides, or contracts with the City and County of San Francisco and its Airport Commission to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to the Airport Commission.

(b) Disclosure Category 3. Persons in this category shall disclose all investments and business positions in business entities, interests in real property, and income from any source subject to the regulatory, permit or licensing authority of the Airport Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.

REVISED LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(12/09/2014, Amended in Board)

[Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code - Conflict of Interest Code Amendments]

Ordinance amending the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code to update the Conflict of Interest Code for the City, the Community College District, the Local Agency Formation Commission, the San Francisco Unified School District, the County Transportation Authority, and the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency, by adding, deleting, and changing titles of designated officials and employees to reflect organizational and staffing changes, and by refining the disclosure requirements applicable to some designated officials and employees.

Existing Law

The Political Reform Act of 1974, California Government Code section 87300, *et seq.*, requires that San Francisco adopt a Conflict of Interest Code and review and update the Code every two years. The City's Conflict of Interest Code is set forth in Article III, Chapter 1 of the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code. The Code designates those City officials and employees who periodically must file public statements disclosing their personal financial interests. The Code also specifies the types of financial interests – *i.e.*, disclosure categories – that designated officials and employees must disclose.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed amendments to the Conflict of Interest Code add, delete, and change the titles of designated employees to reflect organizational and staffing changes made by City departments and agencies since the Code was last amended in February 2013. The proposed amendments also revise the disclosure requirements applicable to some designated officials and employees.

The proposed amendments amend the sections of the Conflict of Interest Code governing the following local agencies: Airport, Asian Art Museum, Arts Commission, Assessor-Recorder, Board of Supervisors, Department of Building Inspection, City Attorney, Civil Service Commission, Community College District, Controller, District Attorney, Department of Emergency Management, Environment, General Services Agency – City Administrator, General Services Agency – Department of Public Works, General Services Agency – Department of Public Works, General Services Agency – Department of Technology, Health Service System, Department of Human Resources, Human Services Agency, Local Agency Formation Commission, Mayor's Office, Municipal Transportation Agency, Planning, Police Department, Port, Department of Public Health, Public Utilities Commission, Retirement System, San Francisco Unified School District, and the Transportation Authority.

The proposed amendments also add a section to address the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency, and delete a section that applied to the Produce Market Corporation.

Background

The City's Conflict of Interest Code must list those employees and officers who make or participate in the making of governmental decisions on behalf of the City. Cal. Gov. Code §§ 87300, 87302(a). A City employee or officer "makes a governmental decision" when he or she: (1) votes on a matter; (2) appoints a person; (3) obligates or commits his or her agency to any course of action; or (4) enters into any contractual agreement on behalf of his or her agency. 2 C.C.R. § 18702.1(a). A City employee or officer "participates in making a governmental decision" when he or she directly, without significant substantive review: (1) negotiates with a governmental entity or private person regarding a governmental decision; or (2) advises or makes recommendations to the final decision-maker by conducting research or an investigation, or preparing or presenting a report, analysis or opinion. *Id*. § 18702.2. The City's Conflict of Interest Code should not include employees who carry out solely clerical or ministerial tasks. *See id*. § 18702.4(a).
