Section 1.

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(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
18 Ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources
19 Code section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
20 Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

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(b) On _____, the Planning Commission in Resolution No. _____,
22 adopted findings that the actions contemplated in this ordinance are consistent, on balance,
23 with the City's General Plan and eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. The
24 Board adopts these findings as its own. A copy of said Resolution is on file with the Clerk of
25 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, and is incorporated herein by reference.

1 (c) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 302, the Board finds that the proposed
2 ordinance will serve the public necessity, convenience and welfare for the reasons set
3 forth in Planning Commission Resolution No. _____, and the Board
4 incorporates such reasons herein by reference. A copy of said Resolution is on file with
5 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____.

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7 Section 2. The San Francisco Planning Code is hereby amended by amending
8 Sectional Maps ZN11 and SU11 of the Zoning Map of the City and County of San
9 Francisco as follows:

Block 5691, Lot 040	C-M, IPZ SUD	PDR-1-G

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14 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
15 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns
16 the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or
17 the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
