Snapshot

- Court Management System (CMS) data from the San Francisco Superior Court indicates 6900 possible PROPOSITION 47 eligible cases.
- District Attorney and Adult Probation lists.
- The Superior Court has ordered the Department of Adult Parole to provide a list of all San Francisco parolees with commitment offenses in order to determine eligibility.
