

My name is Nae Moon Park and I own Fillmore Billiards located at 1530 Fillmore Street, San Francisco. My business was opened in late November 2012 after many months of remodeling the premise to operate as a billiard. My current business hours are as followed: everyday we open at 12 noon and close at 12 midnight except for Thursday, Friday and Saturday when we close at 2 A.M. I want my patrons, people from the neighborhood and from the other parts of this wonderful city to have a place where they can relax and enjoy playing a game of billiard or pool with a cold glass of beer to quench their thirst.

I applied for a new A.B.C license, Type 40, "On-Sale Beer" for the above mentioned premise. My business was opened to the general public starting late November 2012 and is located in a commercial / residential zone known as "Fillmore Jazz District", a part of San Francisco. In my neighborhood, there are many restaurants and bars that serve this community. However, there isn't any single business that provides billiard parlor entertainment in the neighborhood. I offer two different types of pool tables, billiard tables with no pockets and pool tables with pockets for the people's enjoyment.

Having been opened for the business for the past 4 months, on too many occasions, my patrons have asked me why I do not sell beers on the premise and encouraged me to apply and get the ABC license so that they can enjoy a nice cold bottle of beer while they are playing billiards or pocket pools. By having the ABC license to serve beer, I could also provide some light snacks, like already made sandwiches, chips, beef jerky and ready to microwave frozen entrees while my patrons are enjoying a game of pool.

My place of the business is very well lighted inside and has numerous closed circuit cameras to ensure the safety of the patrons inside and as well as the outside for the surrounding neighborhood. My goal is to turn my place into where a father can bring his kids and teach how to play pools: I want it to be a family friendly place of entertainment.
