[Concurring in the Continuation of the Second Declaration of Local Emergency - Rim Fire (Stanislaus National Forest Area)]

Motion concurring in the "Rim Fire" Second Declaration of Local Emergency by the Mayor and in the actions taken to meet the emergency.

WHEREAS, On August 22, 2013, Acting Mayor Mark E. Farrell issued a Declaration of Local Emergency in connection with the wildfire that began on August 17, 2013, in the Stanislaus National Forest Area (the "Rim Fire"); and

WHEREAS, The Board previously and continually concurred in the Declaration of Local Emergency beginning on September 3, 2013, through July 22, 2014, by approving the following Motion Nos. M13-109 (File No. 130809), M13-116 (File No. 130900), M13-136 (File No. 131015), M13-151 (File No. 131104), M13-176 (File No. 131164), M14-005 (File No. 140003), M14-016 (File No. 14110), M14-032 (File No. 140201), M14-052 (File No. 140325), M14-079 (File No. 140440), M14-091 (File No. 140572), M14-109 (File No. 140720), and M14-131 (File No. 140849), which are hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On June 10, 2014, the Mayor's Office submitted a memorandum to the Board of Supervisors, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140720. which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein, confirming the emergency conditions and concluding that it is in the best interest of the City to continue the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, On August 19, 2014, Mayor Edwin M. Lee issued a Second Declaration of Local Emergency, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140894, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein, under Charter.

Section 3.100(14), and California Government Code, Section 8630, in connection with the Rim Fire; and

WHEREAS, The Board previously and continually concurred in the Declaration of Local Emergency beginning on September 2, 2014, through December 16, 2014, by approving the following Motion Nos. M14-145 (File No. 140894), M14-165 (File No. 141009), M14-185 (File No. 141115), M14-200 (File No. 141202), and M14-226 (File No. 141288), which are hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On January 7, 2015, the Mayor's Office submitted a memorandum to the Board of Supervisors, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 150022, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein, confirming the emergency conditions and concluding that it is in the best interest of the City to continue the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, On January 16, 2015, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of the Second Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M15-011, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 150022, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, Government Code, Section 8630, provides that, when a local emergency has been declared, "[t]he governing body shall review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 30 days until the governing body terminates the local emergency;" and

WHEREAS, Conditions threatening the lives, property or welfare of the City and County of San Francisco or its citizens continue to exist in connection with the Rim Fire, including damage to property and equipment of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and Recreation and Park Department resources; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril justify and require the continuation of the declaration of local emergency; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs in the continuation of the Second Declaration of Local Emergency issued by the Mayor, and in the actions taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to agendize a successive motion concurring in the continuation of the Rim Fire Second Declaration of Local Emergency to be heard no later than 30 days from the date of passage of this Motion.

Dear Ms. Calvillo,

At the recommendation of the Department of Emergency Management and the Public Utilities Commission (PUC), Mayor Lee requests to extend the monthly recurring item on the Board of Supervisors agenda to continue the Local Emergency related to the Rim Fire through March 31, 2015. In order to protect the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power System, the PUC continues to seek flexibility to rapidly hire contactors to repair ongoing damage to roads, power poles, and other City assets resulting from rain, snow, and associated runoff in the burn area. In particular, the PUC requests ongoing flexibility to perform emergency tree removal following storms in the Sierra Nevada, which may cause trees damaged by the Rim Fire to block roads and damage infrastructure that is critical to operation of the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power System.

Under state law, the Local Emergency must be renewed every 30 days by the Board of Supervisors or else it expires. As you know, the Board approved a final extension to the emergency on December 16, 2014, which will expire on January 15, 2015 unless renewed. We respectfully request that this item again be calendared for Adoption Without Committee Reference on the following dates:

- January 13
- February 10
- March 10

Second Declaration of Local Emergency (Rim Fire) August 19, 2014

WHEREAS, California Government Code Sections 8550 et seq., San Francisco Charter Section 3.100, and Chapter 7 of the San Francisco Administrative Code empower the Mayor to proclaim the existence of a local emergency (subject to ratification by the Board of Supervisors) when the City and County is affected or threatened by a natural disaster or other emergency posing conditions of extreme peril to life or property; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco issued a Declaration of Local Emergency on August 22, 2013 due to conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property that arose due to the "Rim Fire" that began on August 17, 2013 in the Stanislaus National Forest; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors concurred in that Declaration at their meeting on September 3, 2013 (File No. 130809); and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco issued a Revised Declaration of Local Emergency on September 19, 2013; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors concurred in the Revised Declaration at their meeting on September 24, 2013 (File No. 130900), and has continued to extend the Local Emergency at least every 30 days since then, and most recently voted to do so on July 22, 2014; and

WHEREAS, The current extension of the Local Emergency will expire on August 21, 2014 while the Board of Supervisors is in recess, and the Board of Supervisors is unable to meet to approve another 30-day extension of the Local Emergency until September 2, 2014; and

WHEREAS, I find that the aforesaid conditions continue to exist and justify a reaffirmation of the existing Declaration;

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, Edwin M. Lee, Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco, do hereby proclaim that the emergency conditions underlying the Declaration of Local Emergency issued on August 22, 2013 continue to exist, warranting a reaffirmation of that Declaration and its proclamations and orders.

It is further proclaimed and ordered that:

The City and County of San Francisco also requests the State of California make available recovery assistance under the terms of the California Disaster Assistance Act and expedite access to federal resources and any other appropriate federal disaster relief programs.

It is further proclaimed and ordered that: .

This revised Declaration of Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until it is terminated by the Mayor or the Board of Supervisors. All departments of the City and County of San Francisco are strictly enjoined to cooperate with the requests for material and personnel resources by the Incident Command Staff of said City and County which is located in the Emergency Operations Center of the City and County of San Francisco.
