FURTHER RESOLVED, The application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, Any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application are enforceable through the Standard Agreement; and, be it

Program Application Package and the HRP Grant Documents as required by the Department for participation in the HRP Program.
