#### Conditions for Type 21 (Off Sale General)

- 1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. daily, except from Thanksgiving Day to New Year's day, sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight).
- 2. No more than 5% of the square footage of the public retail space (not including the storage area) of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages
- 3. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 375 ml is strictly prohibited.
- 4. No malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic content great than 5.7% by volume, except for microbrews, craft brews, organic and specialty malt products sold under such designations as stout, porter, IPA, and ESB. This condition is intended to eliminate high alcohol, low-cost products that are frequently abused, but not prevent the sales of specialty and craft beer products.
- 5. Beer, malt beverages and wine coolers in containers larger than 32 oz. are strictly prohibited.
- 6. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than the manufacturer pre-packaged four (4) packs per sale. No wine-coolers or beer coolers shall be sold in less than the manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4).
- 7. No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of great than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles.


8. Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml, unless sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.





Target Corporation ("Target") has applied to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for a Type 21 Off-Sale General license at the new Target Express store opening in the financial district this spring. Because the new store is located in a census tract that has an "undue concentration" of off-sale licenses under Section 23958.4 of the Business and Professions Code, Target is requesting a determination by the Board of Supervisors that public convenience or necessity will be served by issuance of the license.

Target has applied for a person-to-person, premises-to-premises transfer of an existing Type 21 license to its new store location at the southwest corner of Bush and Sansome Streets next to the Montgomery BART Station. The new 18,000 square-foot store will occupy the lower level of the historic 22-story office building (previously occupied by Wells Fargo) and will employ approximately 30 team members. The proposed store hours are 7am – 11pm, with extended store hours during the holiday season.

The new store will be one of the first Target Express stores in California. The new smaller-format Target Express stores offer everyday essentials in a convenient and accessible format. The San Francisco Target Express, centrally located in the heart of the financial district, will provide office workers, downtown residents and commuters, convenient access to everyday essentials. The new store will offer a selection of grocery products including produce, dairy, frozen foods, snacks and beverages, and will feature a large ready-made food area that includes sandwiches, salads, breakfast items and mid-day snacks to serve the needs of commuters and nearby office workers. The store will also offer items from Target's home, beauty and electronics departments, including selections from Target's own brands, as well as a pharmacy.

Along with its grocery and food offerings, Target would like to be able to offer customers the ability to purchase alcoholic beverages. While alcoholic beverages will be only a small component of the overall product mix, the ability to purchase alcoholic beverages along with food items is a convenience shoppers expect. Having the ability to sell alcoholic beverages will allow Target to provide its customers with the convenience of one-stop shopping. Additionally, the two San Francisco CityTargets both sell alcoholic beverages; it is a product customers expect to be able to purchase Target.
