Resolution recognizing the inauguration of the San Francisco Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights, as detailed in this Resolution, on October 18, 2014.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights is a set of outdoor experiences that ensures every child in San Francisco has the opportunity to connect with nature and develop to their fullest potential; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco is a highly visible national and international model of progressive human endeavors in an increasingly urban world; now, therefore, be it
