Mr. Mayor - We have both repeatedly discussed our mutual desires to support and increase the number of community serving businesses along the Third Street merchant corridor. We have also worked extensively together with your Office of Economic and Workforce Development to support existing businesses, attract new businesses, and to fund physical and tenant improvements all in an effort to increase foot traffic and better serve the surrounding community. However, in recent months several non-profit organizations and City agencies including the Human Services Agency (HSA) have been looking for office space on the merchant corridor.
