Correction to Motion No. M14-190, Board File No. 141066

On November 18, 2014, the Board of Supervisors considered a conditional use appeal regarding a proposed project at 115 Telegraph Hill Boulevard (Board file no. 141064). At that hearing, the Board voted to disapprove the Planning Commission's conditional use authorization and approve a conditional use authorization with the Planning Commission's conditions and several additional conditions. Before the Board voted to approve the new conditions, Supervisor Chiu publicly described them and circulated a document with further details. After the meeting, I drafted a motion for the Clerk's file to reflect the Board's vote. Unfortunately, the written motion I prepared did not precisely reflect the conditions that the Board had approved on November 18. After reviewing the video of the hearing and the documents circulated during the hearing, I have now prepared a corrected version of the Board's motion. The corrected motion is attached. This version makes three corrections:

- Page 2, line 9: removing the words "and equipment," so that the staging area requirement will apply to construction vehicles, not "construction vehicles and equipment."
- Page 2 lines 16-17: replacing "federal holidays recognized by the Office of Personnel Management" with "legal holidays recognized by the City and County of San Francisco."
- Page 3, line 22: removing the words "in consultation with the Telegraph Hill Dwellers neighborhood association and nearby neighbors."

The Board should not vote on this corrected motion. The Board has already voted to impose the conditions; the error occurred in reducing the Board's motion to writing for the legislative file. I have prepared this corrected motion so that the file accurately reflects the conditions that the Board approved on November 18.
