Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license from 635-8<sup>th</sup> Street to 115 Sansome Street (District 3) to Philip West for the Treasury R & B Holdings, LCC, dba The Treasury, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS, Philip West is seeking the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license from 635-8th Street to 115 Sansome Street (District 3) for the Treasury R & B Holdings, LCC, dba The Treasury; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) The front door(s) shall be kept closed at all times during the operation of the premises except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door; 2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC-257; 3) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited;

4) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; 5) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257; and 6) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license from 635-8<sup>th</sup> Street to 115 Sansome Street (District 3) to Philip West for the Treasury R & B Holdings, LCC, dba The Treasury, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the license with those conditions.
