Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

- (a) The Office of Financial Empowerment in the Office of the Treasurer-Tax Collector was awarded a \$100,000 grant from the Earned Assets Resource Network (EARN) on August 27, 2014. The purpose of the grant is to hire and provide funding for a staff position to conduct outreach to families in the Kindergarten to College program.
- (b) The City and County of San Francisco established the Kindergarten to College program in 2010 to provide college savings accounts for San Francisco Unified School District kindergarteners with an initial deposit of \$50, provide financial education curriculum, and encourage savings for higher education.

Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Grant Funds.

- (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the Treasurer-Tax Collector to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, funds from the Earned Assets Resource Network in the amount of \$100,000 for the purpose of implementing the Office of Financial Empowerment Kindergarten to College program.
- (b) Whereas the Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funding on direct services by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it ordained that the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget.
