[Preparation of Findings to Reverse the Categorical Exemption Determination - 53 States 1 Street] 2 Motion directing the Clerk of the Board to prepare findings reversing the determination 3 by the Planning Department that a proposed project at 53 States Street is categorically 4 5 exempt from environmental review. 6 7 WHEREAS, On May 28, 2014, the Planning Department determined that the proposed 8 project located at 53 States Street ("Project") is exempt from environmental review under the 9 California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the CEQA Guidelines, and San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31. The proposed project involves demolition of an existing 10 building and construction of a four-story, 7,103-square-foot building containing two residential 11 12 units and four parking spaces; and 13 WHEREAS, By letter to the Clerk of the Board, received by the Clerk's Office on 14 February 9, 2015, Hector Martinez (Appellant) appealed the exemption determination. The Appellant provided a copy of the Planning Commission's Discretionary Review Action DRA 15 16 03-99, dated January 8, 2015, with the Planning Department's Categorical Exemption 17 Determination attached, which found that the proposed project was exempt under Classes 1 and 3 of the CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Reg. Sections 15301 and 15303); and 18 19 WHEREAS, The Planning Department's Environmental Review Officer, by 20 memorandum to the Clerk of the Board dated February 12, 2015, determined that the appeal 21 had been timely filed; and 22 WHEREAS, On April 7, 2015, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider 23 the appeal of the exemption determination filed by Appellant and, following the public hearing, 24 reversed the exemption determination; and 25

1 WHEREAS, In reviewing the appeal of the exemption determination, this Board 2 reviewed and considered the exemption determination, the appeal letter, the responses to the 3 appeal documents that the Planning Department prepared, the other written records before 4 the Board of Supervisors and all of the public testimony made in support of and opposed to 5 the exemption determination appeal. Following the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board 6 of Supervisors reversed the exemption determination for the project based on the written 7 record before the Board of Supervisors as well as all of the testimony at the public hearing in 8 support of and opposed to the appeal. The written record and oral testimony in support of and 9 opposed to the appeal and deliberation of the oral and written testimony at the public hearing 10 before the Board of Supervisors by all parties and the public in support of and opposed to the appeal of the exemption determination is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 11 12 150167 and is incorporated in this motion as though set forth in its entirety; now therefore be it 13 MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to prepare the 14 findings specifying the basis for its decision on the appeal of the exemption determination 15 issued by the Planning Department for the project. 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
