11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1.

14 (a) This ordinance is uncodified.

15 (b) Findings. The California Department of Education recently recognized Lawton  
16 Alternative School as a California Distinguished School for 2014 in recognition of the school's  
17 progress in closing the academic achievement gap. The Lawton Alternative School, located  
18 at 1570 31st Avenue, intends to post up to four banners on City-owned utility poles fronting  
19 the school, subject to approval by the Department of Public Works.

20 (c) Fee waiver. The fees set forth in Public Works Code Section 184.78 shall be  
21 waived for the Lawton Alternative School for up to four banners posted on City-owned utility  
22 poles fronting the school beginning May 1, 2015. All other provisions of Public Works Code  
23 Section 184.78 shall remain in full effect.

1           Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after  
2 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the  
3 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board  
4 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance. However, the provisions of this  
5 ordinance shall be retroactive to May 1, 2015 if the effective date of the ordinance occurs after  
6 that date.
