10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	
12	Section 1. The Health Code is hereby amended by revising Section 470.2, to read as
13	follows. Section 470.1 is not amended but is partially reprinted below for context:
14	SEC. 470.1. ESTABLISHMENT AND MEMBERSHIP OF FOOD SECURITY TASK
15	FORCE.
16	(a) Food Security Task Force. There is hereby established a Food Security Task
17	Force of the City and County of San Francisco. Food security, for purposes of this ordinance,
18	shall mean the state in which all persons obtain a nutritionally adequate, culturally acceptable
19	diet at all times through local non-emergency sources.
20	* * * *
21	(d) Purposes of Task Force; Strategic Plan. The Food Security Task Force shall
22	recommend to the Board of Supervisors legislative action and city-wide strategies that would
23	increase participation in federally funded programs such as Cal Fresh known nationally as
24	SNAP and formally as food stamps, Summer Food Service, the Child and Adult Care Food
25	Program, the Homeless Children Nutrition Program, the Special Supplemental Nutrition

Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC), the School Lunch Program and the National
School Breakfast Program. The Task Force shall also provide general advice and assistance
to the Board of Supervisors with regard to funding priorities, legislative action, and city policies
on addressing hunger and enhancing the food security of San Francisco residents in addition
to any other issues within the Task Force's expertise.

To accomplish these goals, the Food Security Task Force shall prepare an annual
assessment of the state of hunger and food insecurity in San Francisco with

8 recommendations for funding, programs, and policy. The Task Force shall submit the hunger

9 and food insecurity assessment to the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors may

10 adopt legislation to implement the recommendations.

11 Thereafter, the Task Force shall submit status reports on progress toward

12 implementing the plan and meeting the plan's goals to the Board bi-annually.

SEC. 470.2. SUNSET PROVISION.

15 *The measure creating the Task Force is reauthorized and extended and can be reauthorized and*

16 *extended by the Board by resolution prior to January 30, 2016. Sections 470.1 and 470.2 shall expire*

17 *by operation of law and the City Attorney shall cause those sections to be removed from future editions*

18 *of the Code unless extended by the Board by July 1, 2015.*

19 <u>Unless the Board of Supervisors by ordinance extends the term of the Task Force, Sections</u>

20 <u>470.1 and 470.2 shall expire by operation of law, and the Task Force shall terminate, on July 1, 2018.</u>

21 After that date, the City Attorney shall cause Sections 470.1 and 470.2 to be removed from the Health

22 <u>Code.</u>

23

24 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after

enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 3. Retroactivity. Notwithstanding the effective date of this ordinance, it is the
intent of the Board of Supervisors that the authority conferred on the Food Security Task
Force shall be without interruption, and that the incumbent members of the Task Force shall
continue to hold their seats without reappointment.

9 Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
10 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
11 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
12 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
13 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
14 the official title of the ordinance.
