[Calling for the Development of a White-Paper on Private Commuter Shuttle Services]

Resolution calling on the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency to develop a white-paper in coordination with the San Francisco County Transportation Authority, on the City's policy approach to private commuter shuttle services, and report back to the Board of Supervisors.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) oversees transit, streets, and taxis in the City of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Country Transportation Authority (SFCTA) is responsible for long-range transportation planning for the City, and analyzes, designs and funds improvements for San Francisco's roadway and public transportation networks; and

WHEREAS, The City has recently began to see a proliferation of private commuter shuttle services on our City streets, most notably in Supervisorial District's 2 and 6, but could soon see the expansion of these services citywide; and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City's residents and visitors for the City to have a thoughtful and thorough policy approach towards potentially creating a regulatory framework for these private commuter shuttles to operate under; and

WHEREAS, It is crucial for the City to determine whether and how these new private commuter shuttle services fit in to the City's transportation, sustainability, and climate-action goals; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the SFMTA, in coordination with the SFCTA, develop a white-paper that seeks to answer key questions and provide recommendations regarding the City's policy approach towards private commuter shuttle services in San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the white-paper report on, but not be limited to: what is in the jurisdictional control of the City and County, the accessibility of these services, the routing structures, recommendations on managing curb space, training and insurance requirements, consumer protections, commercial requirements, physical emissions, vehicle types, and any other topic or issue area that the SFMTA and SFCTA deem essential to report on.
