

Multifamily Housing Development

- MOHCD has doubled our historical pipeline of affordable units in production.
- Current major projects include:
 - Small Sites Program
 - Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) Program (3,561 units)
 - HOPE SF (275 units currently)
 - 55 Laguna, Booker T Washington, Midtown, 1950 Mission, SWL
 322-1, Hugo Hotel, Balboa Park Upper Yard (approximately 700 units)

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- MOHCD offers a range of downpayment assistance programs for first time home buyers at various income levels, including targeted programs for teachers and first-responders
- From July 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015, MOHCD has provided downpayment assistance to 63 households.
