The proposed Plan Amendment would adopt Planning Code bulk limits for office buildings in areas where the Transbay Redevelopment Plan already permits office use. Specifically, the Plan Amendment would provide that the maximum floor plate sizes for non-residential buildings in Zone One shall be consistent with the bulk limits permitted by Planning Code, Sections 270 (Bulk Limits: Measurement) and 272 (Bulk Limits: Special Exceptions in C-3 Districts) as amended from time to time, for development within the C-3-O ("Downtown Office") Zoning District.

No changes to the existing boundaries of the Project Area are proposed by the Plan Amendment.
