3	Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and			
4	expend a grant in the amount of \$110,276 from the California Governor's Office of			
5	Emergency Services for the Human Trafficking Advocacy Program for the grant			
6	period October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2015, to ensure human trafficking			
7	victims receive comprehensive victim services and to enhance the collaboration with			
8	the Mayor's Task Force on Anti-Human Trafficking.

10	WHEREAS, The Office of the District Attorney (SFDA) applied for funding from the			
11	California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the "Human Trafficking Advocacy			
12	Program" and was awarded One Hundred Ten Thousand and Two Hundred Seventy-Six			
13	dollars (\$110,276); and			
14	WHEREAS, The purpose of the Human Trafficking Advocacy Program is to provide			
15	funding for Victim/Witness Assistance Centers to provide services to victims of human			
16	trafficking; and			
17	WHEREAS, SFDA will use grant funds to increase the identification of human			
18	trafficking victims, coordinate comprehensive services for those victims, and enhance the			
19	collaboration with the Mayor's Task Force on Anti-Human Trafficking; and			
20	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance (ASO)			
21	Amendment; and			
22	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget;			
23	now, therefore, be it			
24	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs			
25	in the grant budget; and, be it			

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office				
2	of the District Attorney to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County				
3	of San Francisco, a grant from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services'				
4	Human Trafficking Advocacy Program in the amount of \$110,276 to ensure human				
5	trafficking victims receive comprehensive services and to enhance the collaboration with				
6	the Mayor's Task Force on Anti-Human Trafficking.
