



We will not be competing with local package stores as we will sell primarily Vom Fass products plus a few other unique and exquisite brands targeted at tourists and upscale patrons of the Fairmont Hotel next door to us. These brands are not usually stocked by corner package stores. For example we plan to handle a few of the best tequilas and our wines will be mostly organic wines primarily from the local regions such as Sonoma and Napa. We, unlike any other Vom Fass stores world-wide, carry local California olive oil and we are committed to supporting the local economy while also catering to the European tastes of San Franciscans. Only open for 19 months we are already contributors to the SF Food Bank and the Aquatic Park Senior Center. We believe we can do more to support our community if we have can achieve improved profitability from sales of spirits and wine.
