Resolution supporting the National Day of Action for Medicare's 50th Birthday on July 30, 2015.

WHEREAS, Health care is a human right, and all Americans deserve affordable, comprehensive health care paid for by an insurance program that brings everybody in and leaves nobody out; and

WHEREAS, July 30, 2015 will mark the 50th anniversary of the signing of the Medicare Act; and

WHEREAS, Medicare is our nation's most successful and financially efficient health insurance system, serving the health care needs of almost 50 million older and disabled Americans, with administrative costs averaging only 2 percent of program outlays; and

WHEREAS, Despite its fundamental strengths, seniors bear significant out-of-pocket health expenses under Medicare and do not have coverage for dental, vision, and long term care; and

WHEREAS, Seniors are increasingly compelled to buy supplementary commercial insurance plans to cover these and other medically necessary services, while employers are shifting from sponsoring these plans for groups of retirees to making limited contributions toward retirees' purchasing them individually; and

WHEREAS, Congressional actions including budget proposals to raise Medicare eligibility to age 67 and transform it into a voucher program and legislation that promotes its further privatization endanger everyone's health and financial security as well as the Medicare program itself; and would dramatically increase health care costs for seniors; and

WHEREAS, Medicare must be protected from these threats; improved so it covers all medically necessary services including dental, vision, and long term care, with no out-of-pocket costs; and expanded to every American so that it becomes Medicare for all, financed by a public, single payer fund;

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports the "Medicare Turns 50" campaign to celebrate the success of the Medicare program and to call for its protection, improvement, and expansion on the National Day of Action on July 30, 2015.
