#### Digest:

Target Corp is introducing a new format to their existing presence in San Francisco. Target currently operates in the south of market at the Metreon, in the Richmond District in the old Mervyn's location and a Target Express in the Downtown area at 225 Bush Street. Target is opening a second Target Express format in the Taraval District. This is a smaller store with a more "neighborhood" approach to consumer needs similar to that of other national chain pharmacy retailers throughout the City. If approved, this license will allow Target Express to sell off-sale Beer, Wine and Distilled Spirits.

ALU Recommendation: Approval with the following conditions

#### Conditions for Type 21 (Off Sale General)

- 1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. daily, except from Thanksgiving Day to New Year's Day, sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight).
- 2. No more than 5% of the square footage of the public retail space (not including the storage area) of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages
- 3. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 375 ml is strictly prohibited.
- 4. No malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic content great than 5.7% by volume, except for microbrews, craft brews, organic and specialty malt products sold under such designations as stout, porter, IPA, and ESB. This condition is intended to eliminate high alcohol, low-cost products that are frequently abused, but not prevent the sales of specialty and craft beer products.
- 5. Beer, malt beverages and wine coolers in containers larger than 32 oz. are strictly prohibited.
- 6. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than the manufacturer pre-packaged six (6) per sale with the exception of wine coolers. Beer coolers which may be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more.
- 7. No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of great than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles.


- 8. Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml, unless sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.
- 9. The sale, service and consumption of powder alcohol or like non-liquid alcoholic beverage based product is prohibited.


