10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12	Section 1. Environmental Findings. The Planning Department has determined that
13	the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality
14	Act (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file
15	with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>150561</u> and is incorporated herein by
16	reference. The Board affirms this determination.

18	Section 2. The Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended by revising

21	SEC. 93. MOTOR FUEL DISPENSING FACILITIES.
22	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting
23	or operating a motor fuel dispensing facility that requires a permit from the Fire Department
24	shall pay an annual license fee of \$ <del>344<u>359</u>.</del>

1 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 2 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 3 Regulation Code. SEC. 93.1. SELF-SERVICE MOTOR FUEL DISPENSING FACILITIES. 4 5 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting 6 or operating a self-service motor fuel dispensing facility that requires a permit from the Fire 7 Department, and jointly administered by the Fire and Health Departments, shall pay an annual 8 license fee of 344359. 9 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 10 Regulation Code. 11 12 SEC. 120. LAUNDRIES AND CLEANING AND DYEING WORKS. 13 (a) Every owner, manager or lessee of a wash laundry will pay the following license 14 fee annually: \$187. (b) Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of dry cleaning that 15 requires a permit from the Fire Department shall also pay an annual license fee of \$344359 16 17 per year. 18 Every owner, manager or lessee of an automatic laundry (mechanical, pay-to-(C) 19 operate, washing or dyeing machine) will pay the following license fee annually: \$29 plus \$11 20 per machine. 21 (d) Every owner, manager or lessee of a laundry delivery service will pay the following 22 license fee annually: \$21 per delivery vehicle per year. 23 The license fees set forth shall be paid annually on or before March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax Regulation Code. 24 25

1	SEC. 223. USE OF OPEN FLAMES AND CANDLES.
2	Every person, firm or corporation using an open flame or candles that require a permit
3	from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359.
4	SEC. 224. STORAGE AND USE OF BATTERY SYSTEMS.
5	Every person, firm or corporation storing or using a battery system that requires a
6	permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359.
7	The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
8	March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
9	Regulation Code.
10	SEC. 225. WASTE HANDLING.
11	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of waste handling, including
12	but not limited to junk yards and wrecking yards, that requires a permit from the Fire
13	Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359.
14	The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
15	March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
16	Regulation Code.
17	SEC. 226. MAINTENANCE OF FIRE FIGHTER AIR SYSTEMS.
18	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business that involves the maintenance
19	or repair of a fire fighter air replenishment system that requires a permit from the Fire
20	Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359.
21	The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
22	March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
23	Regulation Code.

## SEC. 227. COMBUSTIBLE DUST PRODUCING OPERATIONS.

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business that involves combustible dust
producing operations that require a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual
license fee of \$344359.

5 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 6 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 7 Regulation Code.

## SEC. 228. FRUIT AND CROP RIPENING.

9 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business involving fruit and crop ripening

10 that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of 344359.

11 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before

12 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax

13 Regulation Code.

## SEC. 229. HOT WORK OPERATIONS.

15 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business involving hot work operations

that require a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of  $\frac{344359}{359}$ .

17 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before

18 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax

19 Regulation Code.

20 SEC. 230. USE OF LIQUID OR GAS FUELED VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT IN

## 21 ASSEMBLY BUILDINGS.

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business involving the use of liquid or gas fueled vehicles or equipment in an assembly building that requires a permit from the Fire

11	SEC. 232. AMUSEMENT BUILDINGS.
12	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business involving amusement buildings
13	that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of $344359$ .
14	The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
15	March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
16	Regulation Code.
17	SEC. 233. COVERED MALL BUILDINGS.
18	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business involving covered mall buildings
19	that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of $344359$ .
20	The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
21	March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
22	Regulation Code.
23	SEC. 234. PYROXYLIN PLASTICS.
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Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business involving the use of pyroxylin
 plastics that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of
 \$344359.

The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
Regulation Code.

## SEC. 235. ROOFTOP HELIPORTS.

8 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in business using a rooftop heliport that

## SEC. 237. PLACES OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLY AND OPEN-AIR ASSEMBLY.

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, operating or using a building, stadium or structure as a place of public assembly or an open-air assembly that requires a permit from the Fire Department, and where a license is not required

elsewhere in the Municipal Code, shall pay an annual license fee of \$564589 per year.

1 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 2 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 3 Regulation Code. SEC. 238. NITROCELLULOSE FILM AND PLASTICS. 4 5 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of processing, storing or 6 using nitrocellulose motion picture film or nitrocellulose plastics that requires a permit from the 7 Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359. 8 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 9 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax Regulation Code. 10 SEC. 239. STORAGE OF CERTAIN COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS. 11 12 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in any business of storing combustible 13 fibers, waste materials, lumber or readily combustible materials, including high-piled storage, 14 that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of 3344359. The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 15 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 16 Regulation Code. 17 18 SEC. 240. STORAGE AND USE OF FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS. 19 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing, using or 20 transporting flammable or combustible liquids, including flammable or combustible liquid fuel 21 oil, that requires a permit from the Fire Department, unless such person shall have secured a license under Sections 90 or 93 of this Article, shall pay an annual license fee \$344359 per 22 23 year. 24 25

1 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 2 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 3 Regulation Code. SEC. 241. FUMIGATION AND FOGGING. 4 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of fumigating and fogging 5 6 that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of 3344359. 7 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 8 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 9 Regulation Code. SEC. 242. STORAGE AND USE OF LIQUEFIED GASES AND COMPRESSED 10 GASES. 11 12 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing or using liquefied 13 petroleum gases or compressed gases that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall 14 pay an annual license fee of 344359. The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 15 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax 16 Regulation Code. 17 18 SEC. 243. ERECTION AND USE OF ACETYLENE GENERATORS; STORAGE OF CALCIUM CARBIDE. 19 20 Every person, firm or corporation that installs or uses an acetylene generator for which 21 a permit is required from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359. 22 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before 23 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax Regulation Code. 24

# 1 SEC. 244. APPLICATION OF FLAMMABLE FINISHES; AND USE AND OPERATION 2 OF INDUSTRIAL BAKING AND DRYING OVENS.

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of applying flammable finishes, including floor finishes, that requires a permit from the Fire Department; or using or operating an industrial baking and drying oven that requires a permit from the Fire Department, shall pay an annual license fee of \$*344359*.

The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
Regulation Code.

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## SEC. 245. PROCESSING OF MAGNESIUM.

11 Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of processing magnesium

that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$344359.
 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before

March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax

- 15 Regulation Code.

## SEC. 246. OPERATING A TANK VEHICLE.

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of transporting flammable liquids by tank vehicle, and providing such tank vehicle that requires a permit from the Fire Department, shall pay an annual fee of \$344359 for each tank vehicle.

20 The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before

21 March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax

- 22 Regulation Code.
- 23

SEC. 247. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.

24

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing and using *a*hazardous materials, including but not limited to aerosols, cryogenic fluids, and explosives,
that require a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$*344359*.
The license fee for the Fire Department permit shall be paid annually on or before
March 31, in accordance with the provisions of Section 76.1 of the Business and Tax
Regulation Code.

7

8 Section 3. Effective and Operative Dates. This ordinance shall become operative on its 9 effective date or on July 1, 2015, whichever is later. This ordinance shall become effective 30 10 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor 11 returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, 12 or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
