My husband and I look forward to opening our shop, The Spanish Table, this fall on Clement Street. We are a locally owned business that specializes in the foods, wines and cookware of Spain and Portugal. We currently have shops in Mill Valley and in Berkeley, and it has been our hope to find a great neighborhood spot in San Francisco, and we believe we have with the 130 Clement Street location.

We have applied for an ABC Type 20 (retail) license in order to sell wine and beer from Spain and Portugal in addition to the complimentary products that we specialize in (our use is a Gourmet Specialty Retailer). Our hours of operation are during the *daytime only*: 10am – 6pm, Monday through Saturday and 11am – 5pm on Sundays.

Our shop would be unique to the area, as there isn't another Specialty Retailer in the neighborhood with our product mix from the Mediterranean. Our focus is on specialty meats, cheeses, olives, traditional Spanish sweets, and spices from around the world along with cookware, ceramics and cookbooks. We have everything you need to make Paella, including the traditional pans, as well as the rice from Valencia, high quality saffron, Spanish-style chorizo and a great bottle of wine to enjoy with the meal. We will also have a small deli in which we will offer hard-to-find Spanish cheeses.

I have reached out to the Richmond Police Department and they commented that the neighborhood is a low crime part of the city and that they feel our use would be welcomed. The Planning Department has signed off on our use and I have also met with Cynthia Huie, the President of the Clement Street Merchant's Association. Cynthia believes we will be a great addition to the neighborhood. Our regular customers that have been asking us for years to open a shop in San Francisco are excited and we will be certainly attract a lot of new customers to the neighborhood.
