4 **(residency requirement waived), terms ending April 27, 2016, to the Sunshine**
5 **Ordinance Task Force.**

7 **MOVED,** That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Sunshine
9 Ordinance Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 67.30, for
10 the terms specified:

11 Mark Rumold (residency requirement waived), seat 1, succeeding himself, resigned,
12 must be nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists and be an
13 attorney, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 27, 2016.

14 Eric Eldon (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding Ali Winston, resigned,
15 must be nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists and be a
16 local journalist, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 27, 2016.

17 **FURTHER MOVED,** That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 18 1. The membership of the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has a goal to be
19 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 20 2. Applicants Mark Rumold and Eric Eldon, who are not residents of San Francisco, are
21 persons with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Sunshine
22 Ordinance Task Force.
- 23 3. The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has attempted to fill the positions, for Mark
24 Rumold and Eric Eldon were nominated, with individuals who are City residents and
25 who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but have been unable to do

1 so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Mark Rumold and Eric Eldon
2 are qualified to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.

Application for Seat #1

Qualifications, Professional Experience, and Civic Activities

I previously served in this seat from June 2014 until March 2015, when I could no longer serve (as currently appointed) because of my residency change from San Francisco to Oakland. I look forward to continuing to push the Task Force to accomplish its important mission more efficiently and legitimately.

I currently work as an attorney at the Electronic Frontier Foundation (EFF). EFF is a San Francisco-based, member-supported non-profit dedicated to protecting civil liberties in the digital world. As part of its mission, EFF works to educate lawmakers, courts, and the public on issues related to open government, free speech, innovation, and privacy, and the various ways technology can enhance and compromise those fundamental values.

Much of my work at EFF focuses on issues related to government transparency in the national security context. I frequently litigate cases under the federal Freedom of Information Act, and I am intimately familiar with the process of filing public records requests at both the state and federal level. Through my work at EFF, I have also written *amicus* briefs in cases addressing novel issues related to freedom of information laws, transparency, and open government. As a result of this work, I understand both the promise of, and obstacles to, truly effective application of public record laws and transparent government.

I am also interested in local government, and I am hopeful that continuing to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force will provide a further opportunity to apply my knowledge of transparency laws and open government to meaningfully contribute to the San Francisco community. Local government's close relationship with citizens provides a tremendous opportunity for greater accountability and responsiveness from government – qualities that ultimately lead to a better and more participatory democracy. I am hopeful to contribute, even in a small way, to the promise of local government by serving on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.



By day I am the editor of Hoodline, a San Francisco publication that provides balanced daily news about city neighborhoods. Our readers are primarily people who live in, work in or otherwise care about the two dozen neighborhoods we currently cover.

Because of this focus, our mission has similar goals to a public service. Our editorial staff is dedicated to writing about everything that we believe will be of interest to our very diverse audience. Our coverage includes civic and breaking news, local business happenings, and cultural and community subjects, like interviews with noteworthy neighborhood artists and community figures. We might write about a Wiggle bicycle controversy one moment, cover a Tenderloin community group next, and then profile a long-time business in the Castro.

I have worked hard to assemble a diverse team of writers and editors, not simply because we believe in the concept, but because we need people on the ground who understand what matters. Many of the stories we publish today are about topics only certain of our writers understand because of their local relationships and background.

Beyond the relevance of my day job, I personally lived in San Francisco from 2009-2015 before I had to move for financial reasons. Some of my family, though, has been here for many decades and has ingrained in me a deep appreciation for everything that this city has been, and could be.

Business and/or professional experience:

I have been a journalist and editor since college. I began writing about campus labor issues and student politics, but I found a paying news job last decade in technology media. I was the first employee and first editor at VentureBeat, the cofounder of a company called Inside Network that covered niche industry categories, and most recently the co-editor of TechCrunch.

I wrote about companies like Facebook and Twitter from when they started all the way to their lives as global businesses. I left to work at Hoodline in early 2014 because I ultimately wanted to get back to writing for the general public, because I believe local news has yet to really figure out how to exist online and because I care about San Francisco and think it could use more good local news. We are making some progress.

I need to spend almost all of my time on Hoodline these days, unfortunately – we have a lot of progress left to make.





Board Qualifications:

The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force (the "Task Force") was established to advise the Board of Supervisors and provide information to other City departments on appropriate ways in which to implement Administrative Code, Chapter 67 (The San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance of 1999) (the "Ordinance"). The Task Force shall develop goals to ensure practice and timely implementation of the Ordinance; propose amendments to the Ordinance; receive and review the annual report of the Supervisor of Public Records and may request additional reports or information; and make referrals to a municipal office with enforcement power under the Ordinance, the California Public Records Act, or the Brown Act, whenever it concludes a person has violated the provisions of the Ordinance.

The Task Force consists of a total of thirteen (13) members:

- > Eleven (11) voting members appointed by the Board of Supervisors
 - Two (2) members nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists; one (1) shall be an attorney and one (1) shall be a journalist.
 - One (1) member shall be a member from the press or electronic media.
 - One (1) member shall be a journalist from a racial/ethnic-minority-owned news organization and nominated by New California Media.
 - One (1) member nominated by the local chapter of the League of Women Voters.
 - Two (2) members of the public experienced in consumer advocacy.
 - Four (4) members of the public who have demonstrated interest in, or have experience in,

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the issues of citizen access and participation in local government.

- > One (1) member shall be the Mayor, or his/her designee, and serve as a non-voting member.
- > One (1) member shall be the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, or his/her designee, and serve as a non-voting member.

At all times, the Task Force shall include at least one member who shall be a member of the public who is physically handicapped. All members must have experience and/or demonstrated interest in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government. The City Attorney's Office shall assign an attorney to the Task Force who is experienced in public-access law matters and serve as a legal advisor and advocate to the Task Force.

The term of each appointed member shall be two years unless removed by the Board of Supervisors. In the event of such removal or vacancy during the term of office of any appointive member, a successor shall be appointed for the unexpired term of the office vacated.

In addition to regular Task Force meetings, Task Force members are expected to participate in committee work.

Reports: The Task Force shall report annually to the Board of Supervisors on any practical or policy problems encountered in the Administration of the Ordinance. The Task Force shall, as it sees fit, issue public reports evaluating compliance with the Ordinance and related California laws by the City or any department, office or official.
