Resolution commending the San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Community

Collaborative and recognizing the calendar day of September 17 as Constitution Day

and Citizenship Day in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, September 17 has been designated by Congress as Constitution Day and Citizenship Day in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Constitution Day and Citizenship Day commemorates the signing of the U.S. Constitution on September 17, 1787, and recognizes all who have become American citizens; and

WHEREAS, The United States Constitution is the oldest written national constitution in the world that is still active, defining the structure of our federal government and the rights of each state in the union and of individual citizens; and

WHEREAS, Constitution Day and Citizenship Day also recognizes aspiring immigrants who are taking steps to become U.S. citizens, and understanding the Constitution and the rights and responsibilities of citizenship are part of the naturalization process; and

WHEREAS, On July 9, 2013, Mayor Edwin Lee launched the San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Initiative, a unique public/private/nonprofit partnership to help San Francisco immigrants navigate the process of applying for citizenship and promote civic engagement; and

WHEREAS, The Pathways Initiative has reached over one million Bay Area residents, assisted thousands of applicants for citizenship with their application forms, and trained over 500 volunteers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Community Collaborative members for their commitment to San Francisco's immigrant communities, and recognizes them for their efforts to assist, engage and empower immigrants and new citizens; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco recognizes the calendar day of September 17 as Constitution Day and Citizenship Day in the City and County of San Francisco.
