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14	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:	
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16	Section 1. Findings.	
17	(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this	
18	ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources	
19	Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of	
20	Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms	
21	this determination.	
22	(b) On, the Planning Commission, in Resolution No,	
23	adopted findings that the actions contemplated in this ordinance are consistent, on balance,	
24	with the City's General Plan and eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. The	
25	Board adopts these findings as its own. A copy of said Resolution [OR determination] is on	

1	file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No, and is incorporated
2	herein by reference.
3	(c) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 302, this Board finds that this Planning Code
4	amendment will serve the public necessity, convenience, and welfare for the reasons set forth
5	in Planning Commission Resolution No and the Board incorporates such reasons
6	herein by reference. A copy of Planning Commission Resolution No is on file with
7	the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No
8	
9	Section 2. The Planning Code is hereby amended by revising Section 780.3, to read
10	as follows:
11	SEC. 780.3. NORTH BEACH SPECIAL USE DISTRICT.
12	In order to preserve and maintain the mix and variety of neighborhood-serving retail
13	sales and personal services of a type which supplies commodities or offers personal services
14	to residents of North Beach and nearby neighborhoods, there shall be a North Beach Special
15	Use District applicable to the North Beach Neighborhood Commercial District, as designated
16	on the Sectional Map SU01 of the Zoning Maps. The following provisions shall apply within
17	such district:
18	(a) Restaurants as defined in Section 790.91 of this Code and Bars as defined in
19	Section 790.22 of this Code may be permitted as a conditional use on the ground level if, in
20	addition to the criteria set forth in Section 303, the Planning Commission finds that the
21	Restaurant or Bar does not occupy:
22	(1) a space that is currently or was last occupied by a Basic Neighborhood Sale
23	or Service, as defined in Section 780.3(b), or by a permitted principal use under Section 722
24	(North Beach Controls); or
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(2) a vacant space last occupied by a nonconforming use or a permitted
conditional use under Section 722 (North Beach Controls) that has been discontinued or
abandoned pursuant to Section 186.1(d) or Section 178(d) of this Code.

(b) For purposes of this Section, a Basic Neighborhood Sale or Service shall mean a use within the North Beach Neighborhood Commercial District that provides goods and/or services which are needed by residents and workers in North Beach and surrounding neighborhoods. Basic Neighborhood Sales or Services shall be considered to include, but not be limited to the following goods and/or services: Other Retail Sales and Services as defined in Section 790.102, Personal Services as defined in Section 790.116, Medical Services as defined in Section 790.114, Liquor Stores as defined in Section 790.55, Trade Shops as defined in Section 790.124, and Animal Hospitals as defined in Section 790.6, and Limited-Restaurants as defined in Section 790.90.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment

2	the official title of the ordinance.
