The San Francisco Department of Public Health respectfully resubmits the attached revised Resolution Designating Edgewood Center Children and Families as an Evaluation and Treatment Facility, pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 5150/5585.50/5585.55 for Youth Ages 5 to 17 and authorizing the Director for Behavioral Health Services to enter into a Designation Agreement with said facility.

The Board of Supervisors previously approved Resolution 239-15 (File No. 141240, copy attached) with identical policy content. However, Resolution 239-15 mistakenly cited the incorrect section of the California Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC). A corrected resolution is necessary for the California Department of Health Care Services to approve the San Francisco Board of Supervisors' designation of Edgewood Center Children and Families as an Evaluation and Treatment Facility for Youth Ages 5 to 17.

The revised resolution contains two minor changes:
