[Preparation of Findings to Reverse Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report Certification - Proposed Golden State Warriors Event Center Project at Mission Bay South]

Motion of the Board of Supervisors acting in its capacity as the governing body to the Successor Agency to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco directing the Clerk of the Board to prepare findings reversing the Commission on Community Investment and Infrastructure's certification of the Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report prepared for the proposed Golden State Warriors Event Center Project at Mission Bay South Blocks 29-32.

WHEREAS, The proposed project, which the Governor's Office on April 30, 2015, with the concurrence of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee on May 27, 2015, determined is an Environmental Leadership Development Project under Public Resources Code, Sections 21178, et seq., is located in Mission Bay at Blocks 29-32 (bounded by South Street on the north, Third Street on the west, 16th street on the south, and by the future planned realigned Terry A. Francois Boulevard on the east), and consists of: (1) an event center of approximately 775,000 square feet with a capacity of 18,064 seats for professional basketball games and which could be reconfigured for other entertainment and convention purposes with a capacity ranging from 3,000 to 18,500 seats; (2) two office and retail buildings with a combined size of approximately 645,000 square feet; (3) additional retail space in the form of a food court of approximately 32,000 square feet; (4) a gatehouse building along Third Street to provide additional retail uses and house elevators and escalators to below ground parking

WHEREAS, The Office of Community Investment and Infrastructure, successor to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco ("OCII"), in

facilities; and (5) approximately 3.2 acres of open space ("Event Center Project"); and

accordance with California Environmental Quality Act, California Public Resources Code, Sections 21000, et seq. ("CEQA"), and acting in its capacity as lead agency, as such term is defined in Public Resources Code, Section 21067, prepared a Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report ("FSEIR") for the Golden State Warriors Event Center and Mixed-Use Development at Mission Bay Blocks 29-32 (the "Event Center Project") consisting of the Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report ("GSW DSEIR"), the comments received during the review period, any additional information that became available after the publication of the GSW DSEIR, and the Draft Summary of Comments and Responses, all as required by law, copies of which are available through the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 150990, and are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, On November 3, 2015, the Commission on Community Investment and Infrastructure ("CCII") reviewed and considered the FSEIR and, by CCII Resolution No. 69-2015, certified the FSEIR in compliance with CEQA; and

WHEREAS, A copy of said Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 150990, and

WHEREAS, By CCII Resolution No. 33-2015, the CCII has provided for appeal to the Board of Supervisors, in its capacity as the governing body of the successor agency to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco, of the CCII's certification of a final environmental impact report for an Environmental Leadership Development Project; and

WHEREAS, By letter to the OCII Executive Director dated November 13, 2015,

Thomas N. Lippe filed an appeal ("Appeal") on behalf of the Mission Bay Alliance of the CCII's certification of the Final SEIR; and

WHEREAS, By letter on November 16, 2015, in accordance with CCII Resolution No. 33-2015, the OCII Executive Director advised the Clerk of the Board that the Appeal had been

filed in a timely manner and that the Appeal complied with the requirements of the procedures established by the CCII in CCII Resolution No. 33-2015, and requested that the Clerk schedule the Appeal for public hearing before the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, On December 8, 2015, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider the Appeal of the CCII's certification of the Final SEIR for the Event Center Project; and

WHEREAS, In reviewing the Appeal, this Board reviewed and considered the Final SEIR, the appeal letters, the responses that OCII prepared, the other written records before the Board of Supervisors and all of the public testimony made in support of and opposed to the Appeal; and

WHEREAS, The written record and oral testimony in support of and opposed to the Appeal and deliberation of the oral and written testimony at the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors by all parties and the public in support of and opposed to the Appeal is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 150990 and is incorporated in this Motion as though set forth in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, The Final SEIR files and all correspondence and other documents received by OCII regarding the adequacy of the Final SEIR have been made available for review by this Board and the public and are available for public review by appointment at the OCII office at 1 South Van Ness Boulevard, 5th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103, and are incorporated as part of the record before this Board by reference in this Motion; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors in its capacity as the governing body of the successor agency to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco directs the Clerk of the Board to prepare findings specifying the basis for its reversal of the CCII's certification of the Final SEIR for the Event Center Project.
