1	[Accept and Expend Grant - Federal Emergency Management Agency - Purchase Five Ambulances - \$780,664]				
2	Ambulances - \$700,004]				
3	Resolution retroactively authorizing the San Francisco Fire Department to accept and				
4	expend a grant in the amount of \$780,664 from the Federal Emergency Management				
5	Agency to purchase five ambulances, over the period of August 6, 2015, through				
6	August 5, 2016.				
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8	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) responds to over 120,000				
9	incidents each year, including fires, vehicle accidents, and medical and other emergencies;				
10	and				
11	WHEREAS, Given the growth of the City, the need for the Department's Emergency				
12	Medical Services (EMS) has increased; and				
13	WHEREAS, Updating an aging ambulance fleet is a high priority for the Department;				
14	and				
15	WHEREAS, Due to funding issues, the Department has not been able to replace its				
16	ambulances per its approved fleet replacement plan; and				
17	WHEREAS, The SFFD applied for and was awarded a Federal Emergency				
18	Management Agency (FEMA) grant in the amount of \$780,664 to replace five ambulances;				
19	and				
20	WHEREAS, The grant proposal and grant agreement for the FEMA grant to purchase				
21	ambulances were prepared by SFFD and are on file with the Clerk of the Board of				
22	Supervisors in File No. <u>151011</u> ; and				
23	WHEREAS, The use of these grant funds would allow the Department to replace five				
24	outdated ambulances with new vehicles that are more reliable; and				
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1	WHEREAS, The FEMA grant requires SFFD to complete the ambulance project by		
2	August 5, 2016; and		
3	WHEREAS, The Fire Commission recommended approval of this grant at its meeting		
4	on September 10, 2015; and		
5	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and		
6	WHEREAS, The grant requires the City to provide matching funds worth 10 percent of		
7	the total project award, or \$78,066; and		
8	WHEREAS, SFFD will provide matching funds worth 10% of the total project award, or		
9	\$78,066; and		
10	WHEREAS, The SFFD proposes to maximize the use of the grant funds on program		
11	expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it		
12	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the SFFD to retroactively apply		
13	for, accept and expend grant funds in the amount of \$780,664 from FEMA; and, be it		
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
15	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of the SFFD is hereby authorized and		
17	empowered to execute, deliver, and perform, in the name of the City and County of San		
18	Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, and payment requests		
19	necessary to secure the FEMA grant funds and implement and carry out the purposes		
20	specified in the applicable grant application; and, be it		
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the grant agreement being fully		
22	executed by all parties, the SFFD shall provide the document to the Clerk of the Board for		
23	inclusion into the official file.
