LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Due Process for All Notification]

Ordinance amending Administrative Code, Chapter 12I, to prohibit law enforcement officials from responding to a federal immigration officer's request for voluntary notification that a person will be released from local custody, except for adults who have been convicted of a violent felony and held to answer for a violent felony.

Existing Law

Administrative Code, Chapter 12I, prohibits detaining individuals on the basis of a Federal civil immigration detainer unless that individual has been convicted of a violent felony in the seven years prior and has been held to answer for a violent felony.

Amendments to Current Law

This Ordinance would amend Administrative Code, Chapter 12I, to prohibit responding to a Federal immigration officer's request for voluntary notification of an individual's release from local custody except for adults who have been convicted of a violent felony and held to answer for a violent felony
