WHEREAS, Dr. Alicia Lieberman's Child Trauma Research Program at San Francisco General Hospital and the University of California San Francisco is marking its 20th year of shifting the cycle of violence for families in San Francisco and around the world; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Alicia Lieberman has over her 30-year tenure at San Francisco General Hospital (SFGH) and has pioneered mental health treatment for young children exposed to domestic violence and other traumatic life events; and

WHEREAS, She directs the Child Trauma Research Program at SFGH and is a national leader in children's mental health and trauma recovery; and
