Resolution retroactively authorizing the San Francisco Fire Department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$780,664 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to purchase five ambulances, over the period of August 6, 2015, through August 5, 2016.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) responds to over 120,000 incidents each year, including fires, vehicle accidents, and medical and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Given the growth of the City, the need for the Department's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) has increased; and

WHEREAS, Updating an aging ambulance fleet is a high priority for the Department; and

WHEREAS, Due to funding issues, the Department has not been able to replace its ambulances per its approved fleet replacement plan; and

WHEREAS, The SFFD applied for and was awarded a Federal Emergency

Management Agency (FEMA) grant in the amount of \$780,664 to replace five ambulances;

and

WHEREAS, The grant proposal and grant agreement for the FEMA grant to purchase ambulances were prepared by SFFD and are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>151011</u>; and

WHEREAS, The use of these grant funds would allow the Department to replace five outdated ambulances with new vehicles that are more reliable; and

WHEREAS, The FEMA grant requires SFFD to complete the ambulance project by August 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, The Fire Commission recommended approval of this grant at its meeting on September 10, 2015; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and WHEREAS, The grant requires the City to provide matching funds worth 10 percent of the total project award, or \$78,066; and

WHEREAS, SFFD will provide matching funds worth 10% of the total project award, or \$78,066; and

WHEREAS, The SFFD proposes to maximize the use of the grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the SFFD to retroactively apply for, accept and expend grant funds in the amount of \$780,664 from FEMA; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of the SFFD is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, deliver, and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, and payment requests necessary to secure the FEMA grant funds and implement and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the grant agreement being fully executed by all parties, the SFFD shall provide the document to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
