

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Police Code - Storage of Firearms in Any Residence]

Ordinance amending the Police Code to prohibit any person from keeping a firearm within any residence unless the firearm is stored in a locked container or disabled with a trigger lock.

Existing Law

Currently, the Police Code prohibits any person from keeping a handgun within a residence that is owned or controlled by that person unless the handgun is stored in a locked container or disabled with a trigger lock that has been approved by the Department of Justice.

Amendments to Current Law

This legislation would expand the scope of the existing ordinance to apply to all firearms as defined in the California Penal Code, Section 16520, that is kept in any residence, regardless of who owns or controls the residence.
