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ORDINANCE

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Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to create a cash revolving fund allowing

[Administrative Code - Cash Revolving Fund for Office of the Clerk of the Board]

the Office of the Clerk of the Board to keep up to \$100 in petty cash in the office; and making nonsubstantive changes to other sections of the Administrative Code that

establish cash revolving funds for City departments.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Sections 10.126 through 10.132 and deleting Sections 10.132-5 through 10.169-21, to read as follows, with Section 10.125 reprinted only to provide context:

ARTICLE XV:

CASH REVOLVING FUNDS

SEC. 10.125. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS - AUTHORIZED; PURPOSES GENERALLY.

Cash revolving funds for departments are hereby continued or established in such amounts as have been or may be specifically appropriated or made available to each to be used in connection with the operations of the respective departments for making cash change, for making petty cash purchases and for disbursements which cannot be conveniently made by warrants or checks drawn by the Controller upon the Treasury of the City and County.

Such petty cash purchases and disbursements shall be for purposes and within funds available in the appropriations from which said revolving fund claims are to be reimbursed; and shall be in conformity with applicable rules and regulations prescribed by the Purchaser of Supplies and the Controller.

SEC. 10.126. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS - PURPOSES.

Expenditures may be made from departmental revolving funds for such classes of transactions as may be in writing recommended by the department head, approved by the Mayor or Mayor's designee, board, or commission, if any, and specifically concurred in by the Controller.

SEC. 10.127. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS – "CASH REVOLVING FUND" CONSTRUED.

The terms <u>"cash revolving fund,"</u> departmental revolving fund," and "revolving fund," in either the singular or plural, as used <u>in this Article XVhereinafter</u>, shall <u>include</u> <u>be taken to the</u> <u>inclusive of</u> any subdivisions of any revolving fund-<u>which may be authorized</u>.

SEC. 10.128. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS – SUBDIVISIONS OF FUNDS; WITHDRAWALS BY CHECK.

The department head, board, or commission, with the concurrence of the Controller, may authorize such subdivisions in any revolving fund as will effect the most efficient operation thereof; provided, however, that all amounts for other than cash change and petty cash purposes shall be maintained in banks or a bank designated by the Treasurer.

Withdrawals from such banks shall be made by checks signed by at least two representatives designated by the department head, board or commission. A duplicate copy of the monthly bank statement shall be sent directly from the bank to the Treasurer of the City and County.

SEC. 10.129. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS – RESPONSIBLITY FOR AMOUNT OF FUNDS.

1 The duly appointed and acting head of the respective department for which a revolving 2 fund has been provided in Section 10.132 shall be responsible for the full amount of the 3 revolving fund for his or her department. 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LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Cash Revolving Fund for Office of the Clerk of the Board]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to create a cash revolving fund allowing the Office of the Clerk of the Board to keep up to \$100 in petty cash in the office; and making nonsubstantive changes to other sections of the Administrative Code that establish cash revolving funds for City departments.

Existing Law

Article XV of Chapter 10 of the Administrative Code authorizes certain City departments to keep cash in their offices to handle to day-to-day transactions. The Code refers to these petty cash accounts as "cash revolving funds." The Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors does not currently have a cash revolving fund.

Amendments to Current Law

The ordinance would authorize a cash revolving fund allowing the Clerk's Office to keep up to \$100 in cash in the office. The ordinance would also reorganize Article XV without making any additional substantive changes.
