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Motion appointing Amy Landgraf (residency requirement waived), term ending April 10, 2017, and Gregory Dillon, term ending March 11, 2018, to the Graffiti Advisory Board.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Graffiti Advisory Board, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 5.170 et seq., for the terms specified:

Amy Landgraf (residency requirement waived), seat 17, succeeding Jana Lord, term expired, must represent the contracting agency for Municipal Railway shelters, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 10, 2017.

Gregory Dillon, seat 18, new seat, must represent the public at large, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending March 11, 2018.

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Graffiti Advisory Board has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicant Amy Landgraf, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Graffiti Advisory Board.
- 3. The Graffiti Advisory Board consists of twenty-five (25) voting members who shall be appointed as follows:

- B) Eleven (11) persons appointed by individual members of the Board of Supervisors, to serve a term of two years, at the pleasure of the appointing Supervisor (these appointments shall be effective when written notice of the appointment is received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors); and

- > One (1) employee or officer of a private school or art school who operate in San Francisco;
- > One (1) employee or officer of the contracting agency for Municipal Railway shelters; and
- > One (1) at-large member.
- D) The following officials and organizations shall each appoint one (1) member to serve on the Advisory Board:

- > The Director of Transportation of the Municipal Transportation Agency,
- > The Director of Public Works,

If the Board of Education fails to appoint a member within 60 days of a vacancy, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a student, teacher, or member of the San Francisco Unified School District academic branch.

Sunset Clause: The Advisory Board shall expire on March 11, 2019, unless the Board of Supervisors extends the term.
